Rainbow Missions (Seattle, WA base, serving in China)

Rainbow Missions (RM China) – Rainbow Missions is focused on supporting children with autism, blindness, and cerebral palsy as well as their families. Their mission statement includes the following: We are driven by the examples of Jesus Christ who loved and gave help to people with disabilities in His era. We seek to bring hope for a brighter future by providing them with physical, mental and spiritual support and care.

Although the pandemic was very severe and we experienced many challenges in our service to others, nothing can hinder the fulfillment of God's promise! We currently have three full-time staff working in China to develop and support our ministry there. The SY Rainbow training center for teenagers on the autism spectrum has hired two special education teachers and one staff person. We continue to fund services at the rehabilitation center in CC.

Currently, China has about 85 million people living with disabilities. They are in need of physical, mental, and spiritual support and care.
